Interlake Children's Therapy Initiative

The goal of the Interlake CTI is to enhance the delivery of coordinated, regionally based therapy services to children in the Interlake, thus allowing children to reach their full potential. Services are provided using a family centered approach.

This includes all preschool aged children who require audiology, occupational therapy, physiotherapy and/or speech language pathology services.

Partnering agencies include IERHA, Lord Selkirk School Division, Evergreen School Division, Lakeshore School Division, Interlake School Division, Society for Manitobans with Disabilities, Rehabilitation Centre for Children, Family Services, Frontier School Division and Prairie Rose School Division.

Central Intake will assist in identifying alternatives when services are not available through the existing service providing agencies in the region.

Any child with an identified concern in areas such as speech, hearing, movement, learning, fine motor and social development; services are provided within the mandates of the service providing agencies.

How will information be shared?

Parents or guardian must give consent so that information can be shared. Parents, therapists and other team members work together to set goals and make a plan to meet the child's needs.

Occupational Therapists (OT) help with:

Fine motor skills; Feeding and oral motor skills; Sensory processing; Cognitive / Perceptual skills; Social skills; Self-care skills; Play skills

Physiotherapists (PT) help with:

Infant head shape and neck position (plagiocephaly and torticollis), motor skill development (rolling, sitting, standing, walking), gross motor skills (run, jump, climb), muscle flexibility, strength, posture and balance

Speech-Language Pathologists (SLP) help with:

Speech sounds; Using and understanding language; Social language skills; Voice quality; Oral motor control; Stuttering

Audiologists help with:

The ability to hear, understand and communicate; Hearing testing procedures; Hearing aid evaluations.
