Topic: ASD, ADHD, and Parent-Child Relationships

The relationship that exists between parent and child has long been shown to predict how children navigate the world around them. While research has established a clear link between parent-child relationships and parent/child outcomes, this relationship has unique implications when explored within the context of autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD). Our presentation will review findings from research exploring parent-child relationships among mothers of children with ASD and/or ADHD.

Learning Objectives:

- How do shared characteristics between a mother and her child interact to impact parenting outcomes in families of children with ASD/ADHD?
- Which parenting styles are related to greater or lesser levels of parenting stress and family quality of life in parents of children with ASD?
- How do parents of children with ASD understand the underlying reasons for their child's behavior?
