Tricia Kell is a best-selling author and sought-after speaker. She shares her experiences with a unique storytelling ability, encouraging her readers and audience to have a closer relationship with God.

Tricia was born in Halifax, Nova Scotia, and raised as an "Air Force Brat" living both in Europe and Canada, giving her a wealth of "life experience" through childhood years. Later, she developed, owned and managed a successful clothing design company along with other companies.

Through her many speaking engagement, Tricia Kell professionally communicates in front of large crowds, reaching out to both Christian and non-Christian audiences at churches, universities and women's functions, each time presenting a message of hope.

Tricia's award-winning, best-selling book, *Chain of Miracles*, tells her true story of how the power and love of God can change a chain of tragedies into a chain of miraculous victories. Tricia shares how God walked her through the abusive relationship and tragic death of her first husband to the accidents that left two of her children both physically and mentally challenged – to another horrifying incident that nearly killed her current husband.

It has been said many times that Tricia can keep you spellbound with her story. There have been enough tragedies in her life to throw even the strongest person into depression, but to Tricia, depression has not been an option. She explains how, through the power of faith and prayer, she not only survives and today is a true success, but with ever step she has grown to have a closer relationship with Jesus Christ.

Tricia's latest book, *Attitude Determines Altitude*, shows how being willing to follow God, no matter how hard the task may seem, can take you to higher levels in your life. She shares her unique experiences in skydiving, ski jumping and her first time as a celebrity at *Date with a Star* in Winnipeg. Tricia shares these anecdotes with humor and her conversational, honest, and vulnerable style. With biblical wisdom, Tricia's inspiring truth can convince readers to step out of their own comfort zones and experience the purpose God has for their lives.

An inspiring radio and television guest, Tricia has been interviewed on the National program, "It's a New Day" on several occasions, provided many radio interviews and more.
